- Maintain discipline during training sessions and games
- Be organised for each training session and game day
- Communicate with fellow NSNC coaches and offer / ask for support and guidance
- Treat everyone fairly and include participants of all abilities, ages, genders and ethnicity

Coach Information

- Coaches Code of Conduct form must be read, signed and returned to the Coaching Coordinator before the start of the season (copy in file)
- If you are over 18 years of age and are <u>not</u> coaching your own daughter's team, you are required to apply for a Working With Children Card, before the start of the season
- Please read the PNA Competition Handbook, available through the PNA website
- Your team is responsible for paying any fines from PNA
- If a player is injured and requires medical treatment, please complete an Injury Report and notify NSNC of the injury (copy in file)
- Please notify NSNC if you have made an official complaint to PNA and complete a Complaint / Incident Report (copy in file)



Club Coach Role & Responsibilities

- During a game, if there is an issue, which is detrimental to the players and the game being played, please send the Team Manager to the PNA office, to ask for a PNA official to attend
- Team equipment bag please bring to training and game day
- Notify NSNC Equipment Coordinator if you need replacement items
- Electric pump for netballs, located at Matthews, outside café

MVP Award and Coach's Award

- MVP Award is awarded after weekly voting during the season 3 adults including the coach (voting system details in Manager File)
- Coach's Award is awarded by the coach (1 player only) and is focused on who demonstrated great commitment, teamwork and sportsmanship throughout the season
