Open Divisions Policy

Newman Sienna Netball Club (NSNC) is dedicated to supporting the continued involvement of players in the club that are no longer school aged. Our Opens teams often play netball for enjoyment, physical/mental health or competitively.

Policy:

- Adult Competition (players year 12 and above)
- Team selections based on number of players registered, all positions on the court represented in each team and a minimum of 10 players per team.
- Teams may put their own team together, ensuring all positions on the court represented in each team and there is a minimum of 10 players per team. Grading must still be attended to ascertain Division to be allocated to. If you do not provide a team list with at least 10 committed players, your players will go into the pool and be graded individually.
- If players do not come in with a team, individuals will attend an Open grading trial where the club will put you in a team. If players come in with 1 extra friend, the club will try and accommodate them playing together
- Attendance at grading sessions compulsory
- Weekly training session optional (team decision)
- Attendance at weekly Saturday afternoon games essential – any costs encountered for forfeits or single Game vouchers (but not limited to) will be paid for by the Team.
- Team Co-Ordinator Required and cannot be a player (Minimum 1 Parent of under 18 teams)
- NSNC Umpire provided
- NSNC will provide all equipment and any support required by the players and Team Co-ordinator
- Open players will be included in Club events; however, is dependent on the suitability of the said event. This will be determined by the NSNC Committee.
- Registration fees will be determined by the Club
- Players must wear the NSNC uniform
